Progress in Afghanistan

Canada's assistance in improving literacy and access to education for all Afghan citizens opens doors to a brighter more prosperous future.

Education

- 🍁 20,800 men and women are receiving legal awareness training within households.
- 🍁 More than 5100 Kandahari women are receiving literacy training.
- 🍁 Under the Taliban, only 700,000 children went to school, all of them boys. Now, more than 6 million children are attending school, 40 percent of them girls.
- 🍁 35 percent of schoolteachers are women.
